
Kids For All Seasons

General Information

What You Need To Know

We are licensed by the Hawai'i Department of Human Services, enabling us to care for children between the ages of 5 to 12. Children under 5 years old are welcome to participate but must be accompanied by an adult guardian.

It is recommended that parents travel with their child's birth certificate as proof of age, especially if your child has just turned 5 years old.

On the first day of enrolling your child into Kids For All Seasons, please allow yourself ten (10) extra minutes as we get to know your child and have you fill out a waiver form.

Lunch can be ordered daily before 11:00 a.m. through our counselors and charged to your room. Lunch will be served at noon in Kids For All Seasons.

Please be sure that your child arrives to Kids For All Seasons with a swimsuit and sunscreen (already applied), a change of clothing and comfortable shoes as required for the daily activities.

Hours of Operation

Our program operates daily from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Your child can be dropped off or picked up at anytime throughout the day. However, when the keiki are outdoors the Kids For All Seasons Room is locked. In this case, we post a sign on our window to let you know exactly where we can be found.
