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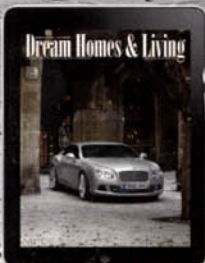

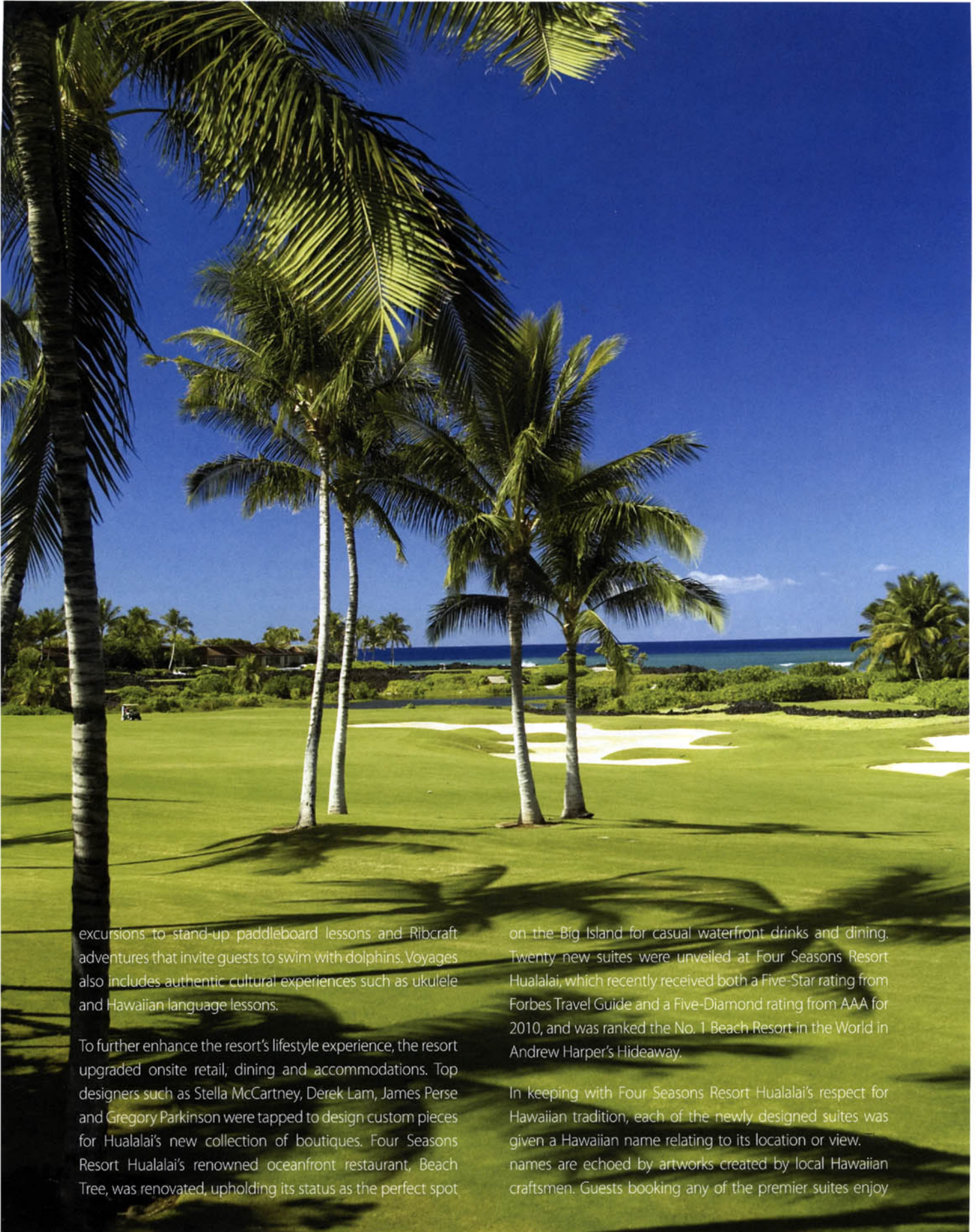
A MASTER-PLANNED RESIDENTIAL RESORT COMMUNITY

Hualalai Resort

Located on the most diverse of the Hawaiian Islands, Hualalai Resort is a master-planned residential resort community perched on 865 acres along the Big Island's sunny North Kohala Coast. Residents at Hualalai enjoy sweeping ocean and mountain views as well as over one-half mile of white sandy beach and amenities such as an 18 hole Jack Nicklaus Signature golf course and clubhouse, a private Tom Weiskopf designed 18-hole course, the award winning Hualalai Sports Club & Hualalai Spa, the Canoe Club and the AAA Five Diamond Four Seasons Resort. The development, which is known for being a world class residential community attracts the world's top businessmen and celebrities, and offers a mix of single-family homes, villas, and custom home sites that capture the true essence of classic Hawaiian living.

Resort

Hualalai completed a 15-month \$40 million resort enhancement in August 2009, elevating its award-winning amenities and setting the benchmark for luxury resorts. The project included an expansion of Hualalai Spa, which introduced a new Apothecary, where guests can choose between a variety of natural and indigenous ingredients that are custom-blended and personalized for each treatment. Hualalai also unveiled Voyages, an innovative collection of active and cultural programs inspired by the "great voyage" that led to the discovery of Hawaii. Activities range from early-morning outrigger canoe



excursions to stand-up paddleboard lessons and Ribcraft adventures that invite guests to swim with dolphins. Voyages also includes authentic cultural experiences such as ukulele and Hawaiian language lessons.

To further enhance the resort's lifestyle experience, the resort upgraded onsite retail, dining and accommodations. Top designers such as Stella McCartney, Derek Lam, James Perse and Gregory Parkinson were tapped to design custom pieces for Hualalai's new collection of boutiques. Four Seasons Resort Hualalai's renowned oceanfront restaurant, Beach Tree, was renovated, upholding its status as the perfect spot

on the Big Island for casual waterfront drinks and dining. Twenty new suites were unveiled at Four Seasons Resort Hualalai, which recently received both a Five-Star rating from Forbes Travel Guide and a Five-Diamond rating from AAA for 2010, and was ranked the No. 1 Beach Resort in the World in Andrew Harper's Hideaway.

In keeping with Four Seasons Resort Hualalai's respect for Hawaiian tradition, each of the newly designed suites was given a Hawaiian name relating to its location or view. names are echoed by artworks created by local Hawaiian craftsmen. Guests booking any of the premier suites enjoy





a daily fresh tropical basket, a private beach cabana and the service of a personal suite concierge. This staff member is dedicated to assisting suite guests with their dining and activity reservations, as well as their personal needs, before, during and after their visit.

Amenities

Hualalai Golf Course, a Jack Nicklaus Signature 18-hole championship golf course is among the preeminent on the Hawaiian Islands and is reserved for residents and hotel guests. Hualalai is the first golf facility to be designated a PGA TOUR Resort, and is home to the annual PGA Champions' Tour, the Mitsubishi Electric Championship. The

Club House features The Hualalai Grille, which overlooks the pristine 18th fairway. The private 18-hole Ke'olu Golf Course is designed by Tom Weiskopf and is open to Hualalai Club members only.

Owners and guests can also enjoy the Residents' Beach House which offers an oceanfront setting for lunch, dinner and cocktails. The Canoe Club, reserved exclusively for Hualalai Resort residents, serves healthy, casual fare. The Four Seasons Resort Hualalai is also home to two beachfront restaurants, Pahu i'a and the Beach Tree Bar and Grill.

The newly renovated Hualalai Sports Club & Hualalai Spa offers a variety of health and wellness programs to create *maui ola*, the power of healing. Recent additions include the Waiea (Water of Life) Garden featuring complimentary pre-treatment spa rituals, a couples *hale* with a private plunge pool and a pre- and post-relaxation area. The Hualalai Sports Club also has a 25-meter lap pool, basketball and tennis courts, rock climbing wall, a 2,200 square foot strength gym with private training consultation rooms and state-of-the-art weight training facilities.

To help resort guests and homeowners interact with the powerful force of the ocean and the topography of the coast, the *alaka'i nalu* (leader of the waves) program is available to assist with water sports equipment, private instruction and advice. The *alaka'i nalu* offer the following ocean activities: canoe paddling, snorkeling, stand-up paddling, shoreline fishing, surfing, windsurfing, scuba diving, boogie boarding, sailing, whale watching & snorkeling cruises.

The Ka'ūpūlehu Cultural Center offers guests and residents an opportunity to learn about Hawaiian values, practices and island heritage through authentic, hands-on exhibits and programs guided by cultural historians. The Cultural Center also houses a CD listening library and video screening room.
