



"VOYAGES" PROGRAM FEATURES 200 ACTIVITIES RANGING FROM WATER SPORTS TO SPA AND FITNESS HAWAI'I ISLAND – Hualālai Resort is focused on providing authentic experiences that connect residents and guests to the culture, traditions and beauty of the Hawai'i Island. Designed to create lasting memories for guests, the Voyages activities are organized into four categories: "Wind and Wave;" "Fire and Earth;" "Sky and Mountain;" and "Mauka to Makai."

## Wind and Wave

Let the Alaka'i Nalu, "Leaders of the Waves," guide guests on ocean adventures that range from stand-up paddle boarding to scooter snorkeling. Families can share

the experience of manning a sixman outrigger canoe or taking a cruise on a 28-foot Ribcraft to snorkel, see marine life and you may have an opportunity to

swim with dolphins. During the winter months, the Ribcraft cruise is a perfect way to get up close and personal with migrating whales. The three-day junior Alaka'i Nalu program, for children aged

13-17, includes activities such as free diving and outrigger canoe paddling. Marine-life lovers who prefer to stay on shore can join in the daily eagle ray

> and fish feeding at King's Pond, the resort's swimming pool/ aquarium that is home to more than 3,000 fish representing 80 different species. And these are

no ordinary fish. Those who join the "Fish Circus" learn how to teach the fish tricks!



## Fire and Earth

In "Fire and Earth," fun and fitness rule. Golf, tennis, spa and sports activities fall into this category, making the most of the resort's amenities and often they come with an island twist. Visit the Hualālai Spa. This 28,000 square foot facility has beautifully appointed private treatment

rooms and indoor and outdoor relaxation areas. Experience the traditional healing practices of Hawai'i served as the inspiration

for the unique Apothecary. A trained staff member helps guests choose from more than 40 natural ingredients which 20 are from Hawai'i, including red sea salt, coconut, ground macadamia nuts and lava mud, which are then blended

with essential oils for a refreshing *Hulali* (sparkle) scrub. Parents can enjoy a traditional Hawaiian Lomi Lomi massage while their kids challenge themselves on the Climbing Wall.

Putts, Pupus, Drives and Drink, for example, is a nine-hole shotgun golf outing at sunset that includes Hawaiian appetizers and tropical cocktails. "Magic Tennis Worlds"

is a unique junior tennis development program, while "Hawaiian Healing Yoga™" combines yoga with the soothing acoustic sounds of the Hawaiian guitar.

## Sky and Mountain

Sky and Mountain activities take guests beyond the perimeters of the 865-acre

Hualālai Resort to experience the rugged beauty of the Hawaiʻi Island. Hikes are organized for individuals, groups and families.

The resort's Recreation Guide can take guests on a hike into mysterious lava tubes and view the last eruption at Puhiapele. The "Hike and Explore Photographic Journey" is a four-hour adventure that teaches guests how to best capture the dramatic images of the island.

Longer excursions include outings to the Big Island Zip-line, hiking the trails

in Volcano National Park, or climbing to the summit of Mauna Kea. During the winter, this top-of-the-world location is the only spot in Hawai'i with snow.



## Mauka to Makai

The ancient Hawaiians connected with each other on the many trails that led from

Mauka (mountain) to Makai (ocean,) and by connecting they carried on their traditions. In the resort's Kaʿūpūlehu

Cultural Center, Hawaiian elders and mea ho'okipa (host) invite resort guests to connect with their culture. Classes range from "Feather Art" to Hawaiian Language, Hula and 'Ukulele lessons.
